Join me for six weeks of "calligraphic time travel", exploring the history and letter formation of a calligraphy style called Uncial (pronounced 'un-shul'). Commonly associated with Celtic or Irish art, Uncial is in a class of its own. Fourth to eighth century historical samples will be our guide in learning a consistent, modernized form of this ancient calligraphic hand. Uncial is perfectly suited for calligraphic beginners and those with experience who wish to add a unique style to their lettering knowledge. Supply list required.
