Beginner Apoxie Clay Have you been wanting to play with the new Apoxie Clay? This is a great time to get started. This is a 2-part clay that works similarly to epoxy, with the exception that it is a workable clay. When the clay dries, it bonds to ALMOST ANYTHING! In this class, you will get a chance to play with the clay in several ways: shaping the clay with tools, applying the clay to rocks, wood, paper, and experimenting with silicone molds. Instructor will provide all the materials for this class.

New Gel Plate Explorations This class will combine a variety of techniques that Wendy has developed over the past 10 years. We will start with the basics of creating backgrounds by manipulating the paint with stamps and other tools. Next we will create multi layer prints using patterned stencils. The third concept will be creating a single monoprint suitable for framing and lastly we will work with the small gel plates creating an art piece with multiple images. A fun filled day exploring the possibilities. Each student needs to bring an 8" x 10" Gel Plate and a brayer (2" preferred but other sizes will work
